Language Options for Grade 6: Kindly note that the students from grade 6 will have the choice of opting the 2nd and 3rd languages (Kannada or Hindi). The details are given below.

Option 1: Kannada as 2nd language & Hindi as 3rd language.

Option 2: Hindi as 2nd language & Kannada as 3rd language.

Kindly note that the language option circular was sent to the parents of grade 6 and the same is recorded by the class teacher. The 2nd & 3rd Language books of Kannada will be issued in the school and the same will be intimated to you later.

Attendance Pledge: A hard copy of 'Attendance Pledge by Student' will be shared on the reopening day. This is an attempt to make the school attendance nearing cent percent. The form needs to be filled and returned to the class teacher on or before 1st June 2024.

Coming to School on Time: Instilling the value of punctuality can help develop any child into a more disciplined person, as they understand and appreciate the value of time. This behaves as a catalyst to make other positive changes in their life and helps to combat any form of laziness from a young age. The students must reach the school by 8.45 a.m every morning on all the days of the week.

Taking Students During the Class Hours: The parents are not permitted to take the students in-between the school hours as this may hinder the learning of the students and smooth functioning of the school. In case of any illness or emergency the parents will be informed by the school to take the ward home. A detailed circular on this has been sent to you earlier through betweenus/Loop. Kindly adhere to the guidelines.

School Transport: The parents who have not availed the school transport facility may contact the school office if they wish to.

Forming Whatsapp Groups: The school does not encourage any student to form any whatsapp groups for any school related/subject related projects. The students must refrain from doing it. The school has created only one Whatsapp group for each class in order to communicate any messages to be sent in a short notice.

Usage of Foul Languages: The students must refrain from the usage the foul languages. The teachers will guide and motivate the students on the same on a daily basis. We request the parents' cooperation in this regard.

Usage of Social Media: At times we find that a few students are found using the social media platform for evil purposes. The teachers guide and motivate on the same through digital citizenship programme. The parents are requested to monitor their wards on the same.

Phone Call To Teachers: You are requested to use the school portal or school diary for the communication to the teachers; avoid sending Whatsapp messages to the teachers. Kindly refrain from calling the teachers on their phone during the school hours and other times. Parents may telephone the school office only if absolutely necessary. Parents may meet the principal, vice principal, coordinators and teachers by prior appointment only and on the scheduled open days.

Bringing Prohibited Things to School: The students are prohibited to bring unwanted items to school such as mobile phones, perfume, expensive pens, fancy pens, fancy pencils, fancy scales, fancy geometry boxes, toys, smart watches etc. Students shall not bring knife and scissors unless they have been informed in writing by teachers. No chocolates and other eatables are allowed at school except lunch box and

snack box. However chocolates are allowed only on the birthday of the student. If the students are found bringing the prohibited items which hinder their studies, they will be confiscated by the class teacher. Also the students are requested not to wear any golden ornaments or any other items which may be a hindrance to their sports and other physical activities.

Grade 1 to 8

Regular Uniform: To be worn on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday.
