THINGS TO CARRY

- 1) Enough Pairs of clothing, school uniform, school ID cards, comfortable sports shoes, sun cap, hand-napkin, towel, water bottle, light woolen jacket (depending on the weather), toileteries, polythene bag for soiled clothes
- 2) Regular Prescribed Medicines (If any)
- 3) Paper Napkins, Hand Sanitizers, Face Mask if required
- 4) Whilst travelling school uniform is mandatory
- 5) Rain Jacket / Umbrella

THINGS NOT TO CARRY

- 1) Expensive Items or Jewellery should not be worn by students
- 2) Any kind of smart gadgets will not be allowed
- 3) Carrying cash along with the student will not be allowed

NOTE

- 1) School teachers will accompany the students to look after them on the tour. However, whilst every possible care will be taken for a safe and smooth tour, the school authorities and their associated tour operators are free from any liability / responsibility arising from unforeseen circumstances beyond their control.
- 2) Students should avoid lending / borrowing of money / articles / footwears/ clothes. Staff will not be responsible for any of these transactions.
- 3) Students using contact lenses must take utmost care. It is advisable to carry / use spectacles for the duration of the tour.
- 4) Students to carry their own 2 luggage tags, the same to be tied on the bags. (1 for hand bag & 1 for main bag)
- 5) The students name, address should be clearly stated on the luggage tags.
- 6) Students should be given easy dragging and numeric lock bags
- 7) Baggage must be light. Students should be able to carry the same without assistance
- 8) It is advisable to carry empty polythene bags for soiled clothes
- 9) Students must remain with their respective groups for the entire duration of the tour
- 10) Swimming / Horse Riding / Boating / Zipline, Water activities will not be permitted
- 11) Request for change of seat / hotel room once allotted will not be entertained
- 12) Students must not talk to strangers during the journey / hotel / sightseeing etc
- 13) Standing at the door of train / bus or sticking hand / head out of the windows is not safe
- 14) Leaving train / bus to buy anything from the stations / halts along the way will not be Permitted
- 15) Parents will be permitted to call their repective teachers to speak to their ward at particular time decided by the Principal
- 16) Cleanliness in the hotel / bus / aircraft / train must be maintained at all times
- 17) Foodstuff / wrappers should not be thrown on the floor but put into the waste bins or garbage bags available
- 18) Punctuality must be maintained at all times
- 19) Damage to property in the aircraft / bus / hotel / train / sightseeing spots etc. will have to be reimbursed by students responsible for the act
