IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

For the students appearing for Class X

BOARD EXAMS

1. Essential Pre-Exam Requirements

- **Admit Card Verification:** Double-check all details, including your name and subjects, on the Admit Card.
- **Venue Reconnaissance:** Visit your allotted exam centre at least one day in advance to familiarize yourself with the route and travel time.
- **Uniform & ID:** Candidates must wear their **Regular School Uniform** and carry their **School Identity Card** along with the CBSE-issued Admit Card (Hall Ticket).

2. Timing and Attendance

- **Reporting Time:** You must reach the centre by **9:00 AM (IST)**.
- **Commencement:** The exam starts at **10:30 AM (IST)**. No entry will be permitted after this time.
- **Departure:** No student will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the conclusion of the exam.

3. Permitted and Barred Items

Permitted Items (Must be in a Transparent Pouch)	Barred Items (Strictly Prohibited)
Admit Card & School ID Card	Mobile Phones, Smart Watches, Bluetooth devices
Blue/Royal Blue Ink (Ball/Gel) Pens	Calculators (unless specifically permitted for Dyscalculia)
Eraser, Scale, Geometry Box	Health bands, Earphones, Microphones, Cameras
Transparent Writing Board	Wallets, Goggles, Handbags, or non-transparent pouches
Transparent Water Bottle (No labels)	Eatables (except for diabetic students)
Analogue Watch	Printed/Written material, Bits of paper, Scanners
Metro Card, Bus Pass, and necessary cash	Bags of any kind

4. Examination Hall Protocol

- **Answer Booklet Details:** Ensure all details and your full name are written exactly as they appear on your Admit Card.
 - **Question Paper Set:** You must mention the correct Question Paper Set in both the Answer Book and the Attendance Sheet.
 - **Social Media Conduct:** Do not spread rumors or post exam-related material on WhatsApp, YouTube, Twitter (X), or any other platform.

5. Penalties for Unfair Means (UFM)

CBSE categorizes violations into five levels of severity. Below is a summary of the consequences:

- **Category 1 (Possession of material/breach of rules):** Cancellation of the current exam in that subject.
- **Category 2 (Malpractice/Cheating/Assisting others):** Cancellation of the current exam in **all** subjects; student must wait until next year to re-appear.
- **Category 3 (Smuggling papers/Electronic devices/Violence):** Cancellation of current and next year's exams.
- **Category 4 (Impersonation/Social Media leaks):** Cancellation of current and next **three years'** exams.
- **Category 5 (Obscene language/Currency notes in booklets):** Forfeiture of money and mandatory counseling by the UFM committee.

Note: The use of ChatGPT or any AI communication device is strictly prohibited and will be booked under UFM activity.

EXAM DAY CHECKLIST

Class X Board Examinations

Before you head out, use this checklist to ensure you are fully prepared and compliant with the Board's regulations.

Documentation (The "Must-Haves")

- **CBSE Admit Card:** Printed and verified for correct details.
- **School Identity Card:** Current and valid.

Essential Stationery (Inside a Transparent Pouch)

- **Writing Tools:** Blue or Royal Blue ink pens (Ball/Gel).
- **Geometry Kit:** Pencil, eraser, scale, and compass.
- **Writing Board:** Must be **clear/transparent** with no writing on it.

Personal Items

- **Uniform:** Clean, regular school uniform (Mandatory).
- **Watch: Analogue only.** (Smart watches/Health bands are barred).
- **Water Bottle:** Transparent and **label-free**.
- **Travel Essentials:** Metro card, bus pass, or exact change for transport.

Final Morning Check

- **No Electronics:** Double-check pockets for phones, earphones, or Bluetooth devices.
 - **No Paper:** Ensure no old notes or bits of paper are accidentally left in your pockets or geometry box.
 - **Departure Time:** Aim to leave early enough to arrive at the centre by **8:45 AM**.
