COMPETITIVE EXAMS

School emphasizes giving maximum opportunities to students to explore their potential and passion. This year our students participated in the Innoventure Challenge, SOF Olympiad, Homi Bhabha Competition and Scholarship exams. We could achieve a few milestones this year and those are –

- Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) :- 392 students of our school appeared in Olympiad exams this year and secured 12 Gold Medal of Excellence in IGKO; 12 Gold Medal of Excellence in IEO. 7 students are qualified for 2nd level in IMO along with 2 Medals of Distinction and 20 Gold medalists. Hearty Congratulations and All the best for Level-2 exams.
- Innoventure Challenge 2023-24: Innoventure is India's 1st national-level Ideation and Entrepreneurship Challenge for children 9 to 14 years old. It is organized by Intelligence Plus every year. This competition allows students to have insightful performance reports on creativity, innovation and critical thinking. The Innoventure Challenge is aligned with the Skill India and start-up India Mission. 07 students participated in it. Out of these 02 students have qualified for the second round.

We are proud to announce that *Tanvi Jhawar and Palak Kabra from grade IX* are qualified in the final round which will be conducted in the month of February, 2024.

- **Homi Bhabha**: Students of VI and IX participated in this exam. Tanishka Karwa & Shivam Sawant of Grade IX, Rijul Patil & Charvi Heda of Grade VI qualified in Homi Bhabha Exam.
- **Scholarship**: This exam is conducted by Maharashtra State Council of Examination, Pune which gives students an opportunity to showcase their academic skills and rewards them with different benefits in their journey of education. A total of 17 students from Grades 5th and 8th are preparing for this exam under the guidance of teachers.

SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

- 3. **Miss. Radha Lele :** from Grade 7 has participated in Block level DSO Yoga championship and ranked 1st in Traditional Yoga
- 4. **Mast. Tanmay Kawad**: from Grade 10 has participated in Block level Chess Competition and bagged 1st rank in Under 17 Boys
- 5. **Miss. Diya Jaju**: from Grade 9 has participated in Block level Chess Competition and bagged 1st rank in Under 17 Girls. Also she has participated in District level Chess Competition and secured 2nd rank in Under 17 Girls

IMPORTANT PROGRAMS

1. Integrated English: Under integrated English we celebrated four (4) themes -

The first theme was **TECH IT-UP! A world of Gadgets and Gizmos** :- Under this theme, we learned about the devices and revolution in communication media. School organized a field trip for the students of I to VIII at Reliance Electronics and ICO Spinning mill for the real life experiences.

The next theme was **Young Entrepreneurs – Discovering the businessman in You** and it was concluded with the culminating event The Bizkids Bazaar. Children learned to make and use their business tricks in the Bazaar organized in school.

In the second half of the year, we dived into the next theme Mythbusters – Uncovering Myths, Fairy Tales and Legends Engraved in Time'. The students learnt about myths and are able to differentiate between Myths and Legends. It was concluded with the event Believe it or Not. Students showcased their learning through dances and skit acts.

Our ongoing theme – **Significant People – Characters and Events that changes the world**' started with jumpstart activities. The module has been designed for the students to know about the famous personalities and their contributions for human welfare.

2. **School Club**: After School Club at PIS is not merely a collection of school activities, but a well-formulated and comprehensive plan to help the development of each child's excellence beyond the classroom.

This year we had Gourmet Club, Treasure Trove Club , Music & More. All students across grades I to VIII were divided into 3 clubs to hone their passion and reach their potential.

- 3. **Vocational Guidance :** From the last 7 years, Podar is providing the Vocational Assessment for students of grades IX and X. This program helps the students to understand their IQ. Aptitude and Interest to make better choices in selecting a career.
- 4. **Annual Sports**: School has organized the most awaited event i.e Annual Sports Day with great enthusiasm and zeal. Shri. Ganesh Naykude, Founder and Chairman of Gurukul Academy, Abdul Lat graced the occasion as chief guest.

The day is meant to commemorate the legend and create awareness of the importance of sports, fitness and health. Our students and parents thoroughly enjoyed the event. Students have energetically participated with great team spirit. The event included a Welcome dance, March Past, Torch Run, Students' class-wise displays, student hits, sports events for Parents and Teachers, and a Closing dance.

5. **Investiture Ceremony:** Investiture Ceremony is an occasion where the newly elected Prefect Body of Student Council steps into the leadership role and takes an oath to deliver their duties promptly this striving to impact the school community positively on the success path.

Shri Anway Chikate, Principal, PIS Karad , Col. SP Kulkarni sir, GM, Kolhapur Hub and Mr Ishwar Patil Sir, Principal, Podar International School, Ichalkaranji were the chief guests for this occasion.

The investiture ceremony is an important occasion where a school entrusts its upcoming leaders with certain roles and responsibilities. Delegation of responsibility and giving authority to children is important as it teaches them lifelong skills of being powerful and caring at the same time.

Students were feeling glad to achieve their positions in the Students Council and carried a feeling of pride with a promise to abide by their roles and responsibilities.

6. **Fire Mock Drills:** Mock fire drills and evacuation drills were executed for the entire school to create awareness and preparedness during calamities. The students were trained to be alert, quick and responsible, follow instructions, maintain calm and avoid panic to avert stampedes and casualties. The purpose of conducting fire drills is to ensure that in the event of an actual fire-related emergency at a school building, all staff and students will know how to evacuate the school buildings in the shortest possible time and without confusion. The entire staff and all the students actively participated in it by following all safety precautions. Mock situations were created to arouse awareness among students.

Students were briefed about the usage of fire extinguishers, and safety measures to be taken in case of fire and evacuation.

7. **Transport Mock Drill**: Students were also oriented with transport-related safety measures with the time bounded demonstration and hands-on experience to use the related aids.

CO-SCHOLASTIC EVENTS
