
traditional way of question answer pattern. It's mainly understanding and answering the questions based on your interpretation of things.

Grade 8 has Pre-mock and Mock Exam for Checkpoint Exam preparation

Grade 10 has Pre-mock and Mock Exam for IGCSE Exam preparation.
