Types of Sentences

 **Declarative** - a statement
I have a basketball game tonight.
I just finished reading that book.

 **Interrogative** - a question
Will you come to my game?
Have you ever read this book?

 **Exclamatory** - an exclamation
We won the game!
This is the best book I have ever read!

 **Imperative** - a command or request
Please come and watch me play.
Read this amazing book!

DECLARATIVE

Tells us a statement.
Ends in a period.

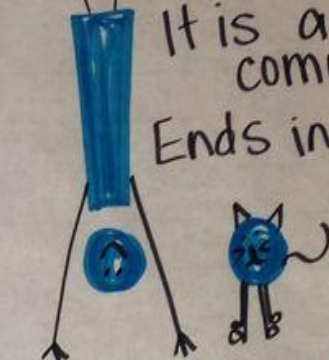


Ex: I'm hungry.

I slipped on a banana peel.

IMPERATIVE

Tells us
to do something.
It is a
command.
Ends in (!) or ()

INTERROGATIVE

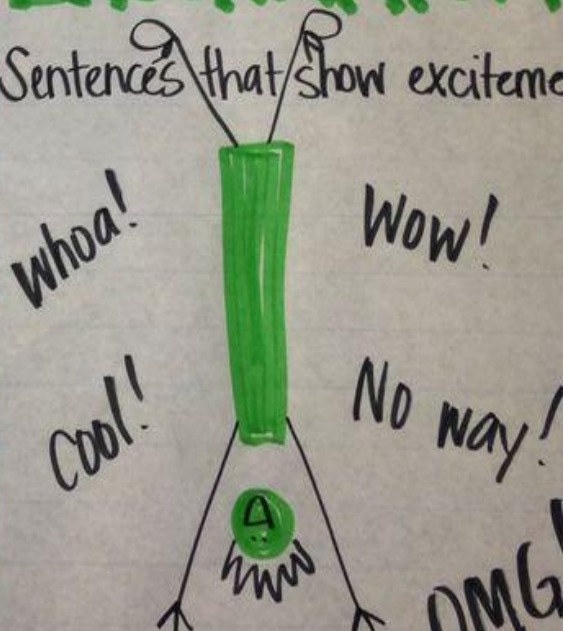
Asks us a question. Ends
in a (?).
