Key benefits of Tinkercad for students are: To use interface easily, Accessibility and flexibility, Creative expressions, STEM integration. Beyond just 3D design, Tinkercad allows students to explore circuits and coding through its "Circuits" feature, promoting cross-curricular learning in STEM subjects. Project-based learning is enhanced. Students can work on tangible projects, which enhances engagement and provides a sense of accomplishment as they see their designs materialize. It develops critical thinking skills Students can potentially 3D print their designs, allowing them to see the practical implications of their creations. Ashadhi Ekadashi Celebration



Ganpati Celebration




Birthday Celebration of school Didi's and Bus Dada's:
