The school reopened on **27th May 2019** for the academic session 2019-20.

After the reopening of the school, the School Management Committee meeting was conducted on the **29th of May 2020**.

In order to help/ support the school in student's welfare, improvement and development, a parent teacher association was formed on **29th June 2019** and the meetings were conducted on **16th Nov 2019** , **29th Feb 2020** with the shared agenda.

For the care, protection, treatment, development and rehabilitation of children in need of care and protection, as well as to provide for their basic needs and protection, a **child welfare committee** was formed on **4th Jan 2020**.

As a part of child welfare committee, boys welfare and girls welfare committee was formed **4th Jan 2020**.

This year has been a year of glory having a lot of achievements made by our children moving in and out of Podar campus.

1. **Beanstalk Olympiad**- we had 63 students who appeared for the examination in English, Maths and Science. It's an honour to announce, **Master Advait Joshi of Grade 5** has bagged **1st** position in State level Maths Beanstalk Olympiad.
The other achievers are on the screen.
2. 64 students appeared for the spell bee examination at school level out of which 27 students were qualified for the next level.
It's a matter of pride to share that **Miss Aadhya Garg of Grade 2** bagged **32nd** position in category 1 in national level spell bee competition out of 200+ students held at Coimbatore.
Here we have list of students who have qualified for the next level.
3. Our students have represented for state level swimming competition at City Corporation swimming pool Mangalore and have bagged prizes.
4. 65 students participated in various competitions outside the Podar campus which includes sports, art, literature, talent search, model making etc.
5. The organization has received 4 awards this year – *Outstanding education network ; best use of technology in education, best organization to work with education sector; India's leading school chain of the year 2019;*

This year we have many new aspects that are added to achieve better learning outcomes:

1. **Activities like 15 books campaign, literacy circle program and One Nation Reading together** enabled children to upkeep the habit of reading and stay aware about the current affairs.
2. **Google questions** on maths and science have increased application skills among children.
3. **Daily report** has come out as an efficient tool for communication with parents on daily basis.
4. School has **initiated water bell** which has been appreciated by the parents as well as the govt bodies.
5. **School Radio** has served as a great medium to schedule and broadcast the live programs every afternoon which are directed, edited and broadcasted by the children themselves. This has enhanced the social skills and confidence in children.
6. As part of **empowering leadership qualities**, the **school council** was reworked. Apart from school council, there is now a class council and house of leaders which was inducted on the investiture day with an oath of office. This aggregates to approximately 50% of students owning the leadership responsibilities.
7. Implementation of **Incident/ accident record system of international standards** has led to efficient tracking and control of incidents/ accidents.
8. **Eco friendly practices** such as segregation of waste and reduction of paper usage have brought children close to nature enabling them to understand sustainable development.
9. Utilization of **different passes** during the school hours has helped in smooth regulation of the children's movement in the school premises.

Trainings:

Student enrichment program:

1. Students were sensitized on safety and hygiene issues of puberty in a session conducted by Nurse and counsellor.
2. A discourse on "Space Interstellar" by ISRO scientist- Dr. Jayalakshmi gave an insight to the children on detailing on various missions.
