Academic concerns:

- Grade 10: Teachers of grade 10 need to concentrate more on solving sample papers for revision. Teachers to give individual attention.
- Grade 2: Teachers should concentrate on notebook and workbook correction.
- Grade 6: Regarding the completion of Kannada and Hindi syllabus and revision for half yearly

exam. Students are given note book completion as homework. Home work should be mentioned in-detail in the daily report.

General concerns:

• Grade 2:

Distributing the certificates during school assembly Art activities should be completed during the school hours. Students should be allowed to watch peer performance of all the competition.

- Grade 5: Sessions about good touch, Bad touch and menstrual cycle. Difficulty in producing Medical fitness certificate.
- Grade 4: Loop learning training for parents.
- Grade 10: Requirement for better ventilated room for grade 10 second language students. Parents to encourage student to write answers for question bank referring text book rather than online reference.

Administrative discussion:

- Administrative and financial decision for next academic year.
- Paid Sports activity.

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MINUTES OF THE MEETING:

- GRADE 10 PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE SHARED A CONCERN ABOUT SOLVING THE SAMPLE PAPER FOR REVISION OF GRADE 10 AND ALSO GIVING INDIVIDUAL ATTENTION TO THE STUDENTS.
- Grade 10 subject teachers after discussion informed that sample papers will be given and also be discussed as a part of revision.
- Students will also be given individual attention by all the grade 10 teachers.
- GRADE 2 PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE SHARED A CONCERN ABOUT NOTE BOOK AND WORKBOOK CORRECTION FOR HINDI SUBJECT.
- It was addressed that the concern will be looked into and made sure that the books will be corrected within 2 or 3 days.
 GRADE 6: PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE SHARED A CONCERN REGARDING THE COMPLETION OF SYLLABUS FOR KANNADA AND HINDI SUBJECT FOR THE EXAM AND REVISION TIME FOR THE SAME AND GIVING NOTEBOOK COMPLETION AS HOMEWORK.
- The concerns were addressed and shared that the matter will be looked into and the portions will be completed on time and proper revision will be given for exams in future.
- Only 30% of the work will be given as homework after the discussion regarding the topic in the class according to the prescribed homework schedule.
- The students will be explained about the word limit required during answering the question based on the marks assigned.

GENERAL CONCERNS:

PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE OF GRADE 2 SHARED THAT DISTRIBUTING OF THE CERTIFICATES SHOULD BE DONE IN THE ASSEMBLY. STUDENTS SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO WATCH THEIR PEER GROUP PERFORMANCES. ART ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE COMPLETED AT HOME.

- It was informed that distribution of certificate will be planned to be distributed in the assembly.
- Allowing students to watch performance of their peers might hinder the academic session as there
 are many activities planned for each class and category and also due to non-availability of space it is
 difficult to accommodate all the students during the performances during the rainy weather.
- It was informed that as students of grade 2 are not given with the homework in the major subjects it
 was fine for students to do some of the art activities at home.

GRADE 4 PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE REQUESTED FOR LOOP LEARNING TRAINING.

 It was mutually decided that training for loop learning will be given to the parents shortly by loop learning team.

GRADE 5: PTA EXCEUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER REPRESENTATIVE SHARED THAT THE STUDENTS MUST BE GIVEN SESSIONS ABOUT GOOD TOUCH BAD TOUCH AND MENSTRUAL CYCLE. DIFFICULTY IN PRODUCING THE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE:

- It was informed that the sessions will be planned in the upcoming days,
- After the restriction on submitting medical fitness certificate is been imposed it is observed that the absence rate has gradually reduced. So, this imposition would continue
