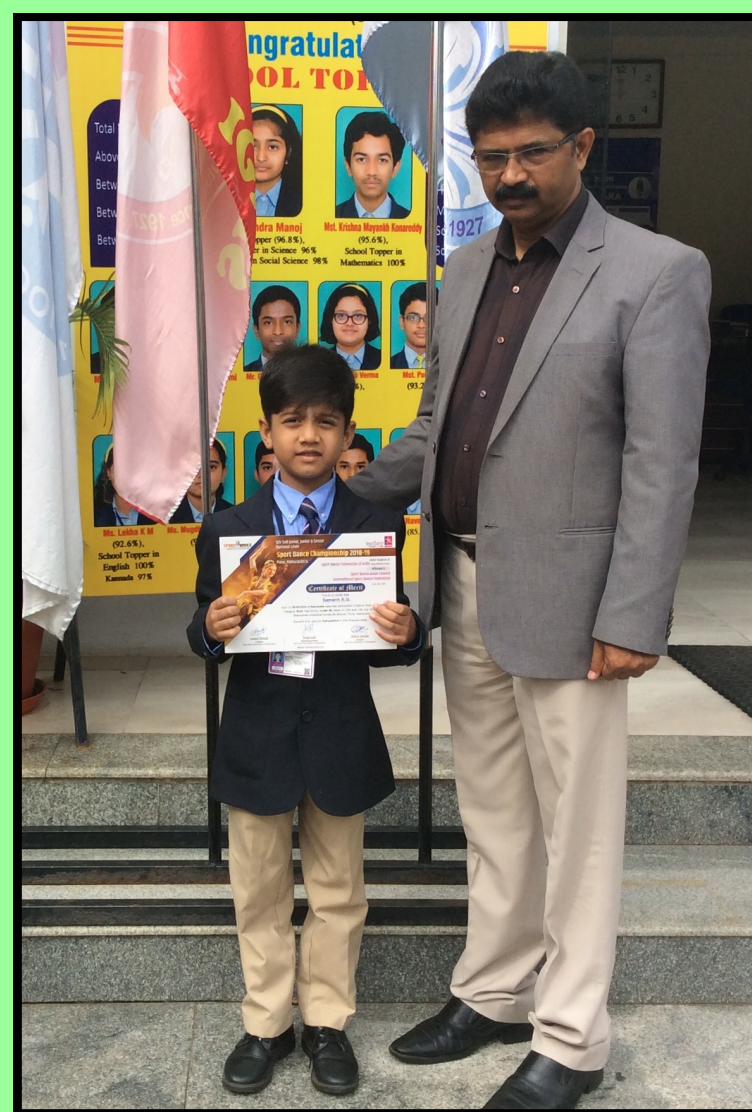
YOUNG ACHIEVERS
