'MYSTICAL RAINFORESTS'- Exploring Life Under Nature's Green Umbrella! Through this module an attempt was made by the students to understand rainforests and their impact on human life. The students also learned about the three aspects of the rainforests - people, animals and life; how they have adapted in their neighbourhood to the climate and habitats. As species disappear or become extinct we begin to see the vital links that exist among species and how different countries and organizations are helping to save our rainforests. Many activities were conducted grade-wise.

Grade 1 & 2 – 'Match the Rainforests Animals with the Info card'; students identified the pictures of animals found in rainforests. Grade 3 & 4 – 'What I Feel About'; students had an opportunity to express their feelings for the forests by writing on the paper and pasting it on the soft board.

Grades 5 to 8 - 'Minute to Win It'; students were given one minute to write as many as words related to rainforests.


