Ganesh Chaturthi Celebration

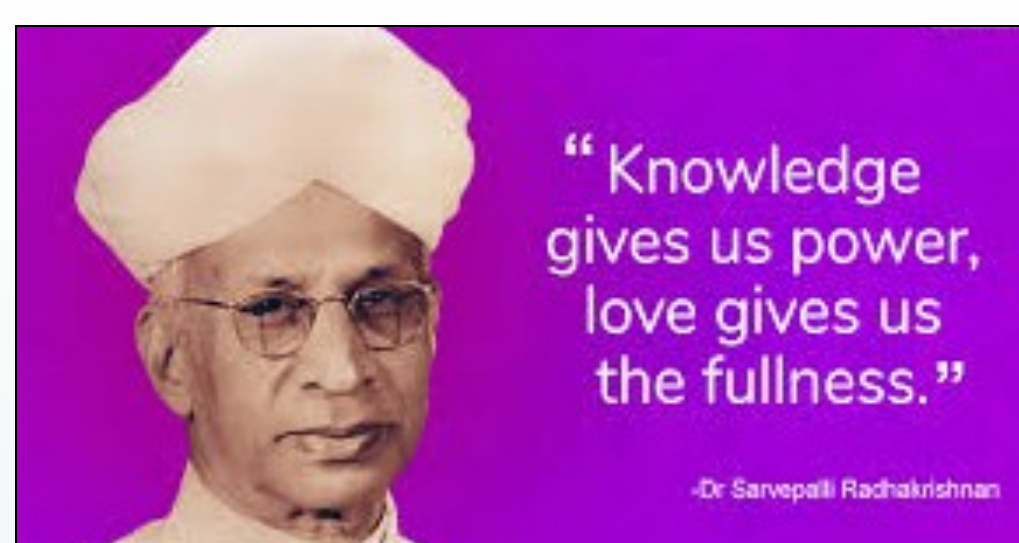
