Prohibited Items:

- Mobile phones
- Perfumes
- Expensive pens
- Fancy pens
- Fancy pencils
- Fancy scales
- Fancy geometry boxes
- Toys
- Smart watches
- Knives and scissors (unless specifically required for a class and informed in writing by teachers)

Food and Eatables:

- No chocolates or other eatables are allowed, except for lunch boxes and snack boxes.
- Chocolates are permitted only on a student's birthday.

Confiscation of Prohibited Items and Guidelines:

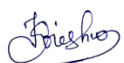
- If students are found bringing prohibited items that may hinder their studies, these items will be confiscated by the class teacher.
- Students are requested not to wear golden ornaments or any other items that may hinder their sports and physical activities.
- Parents are advised **not to send money with their wards**, as some students have been found indulging in **business activities by selling cards**.
- Any student found engaging in business activities within the school premises will **face strict disciplinary action**.
