House Competition -Right or Wrong



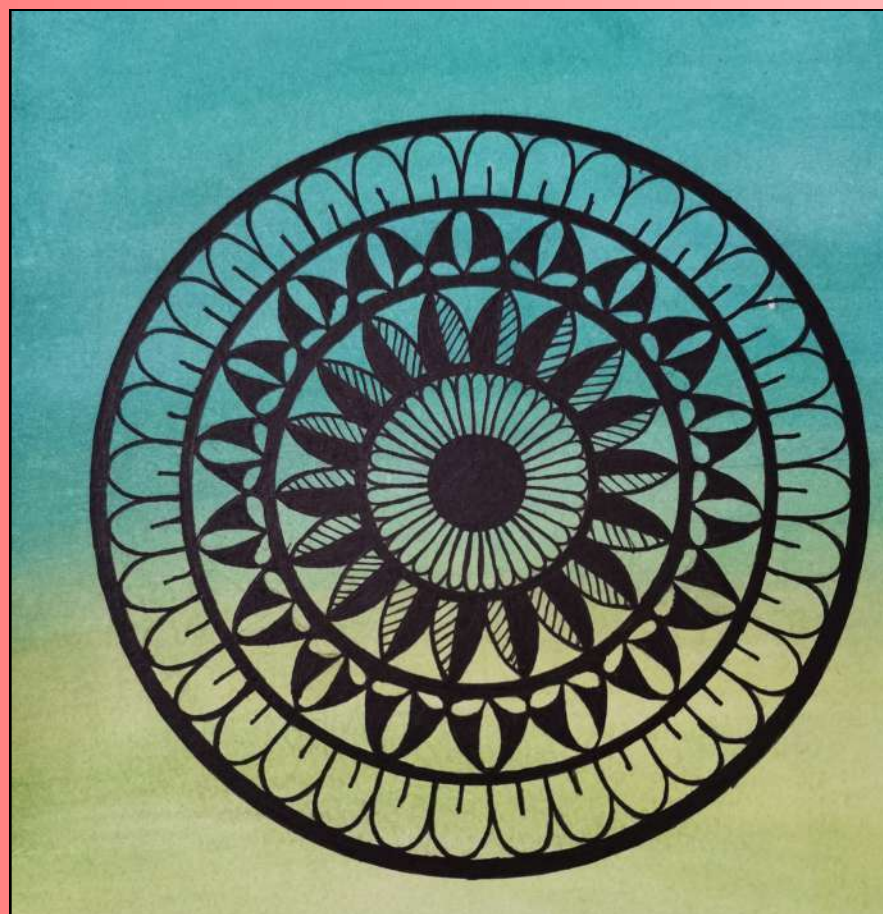
