“Everyone has a will to win but only a few have the will to prepare to win.” Self belief is the key to success. PIS teachers keep high expectations

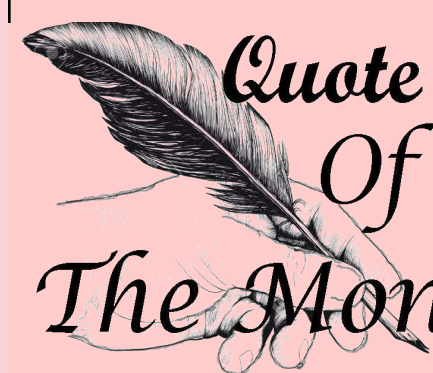
from all their students. Most of you stand up to those expectations. Improving your earlier performance is called progress. With determination, persistence and self belief, you will achieve what you want to achieve.

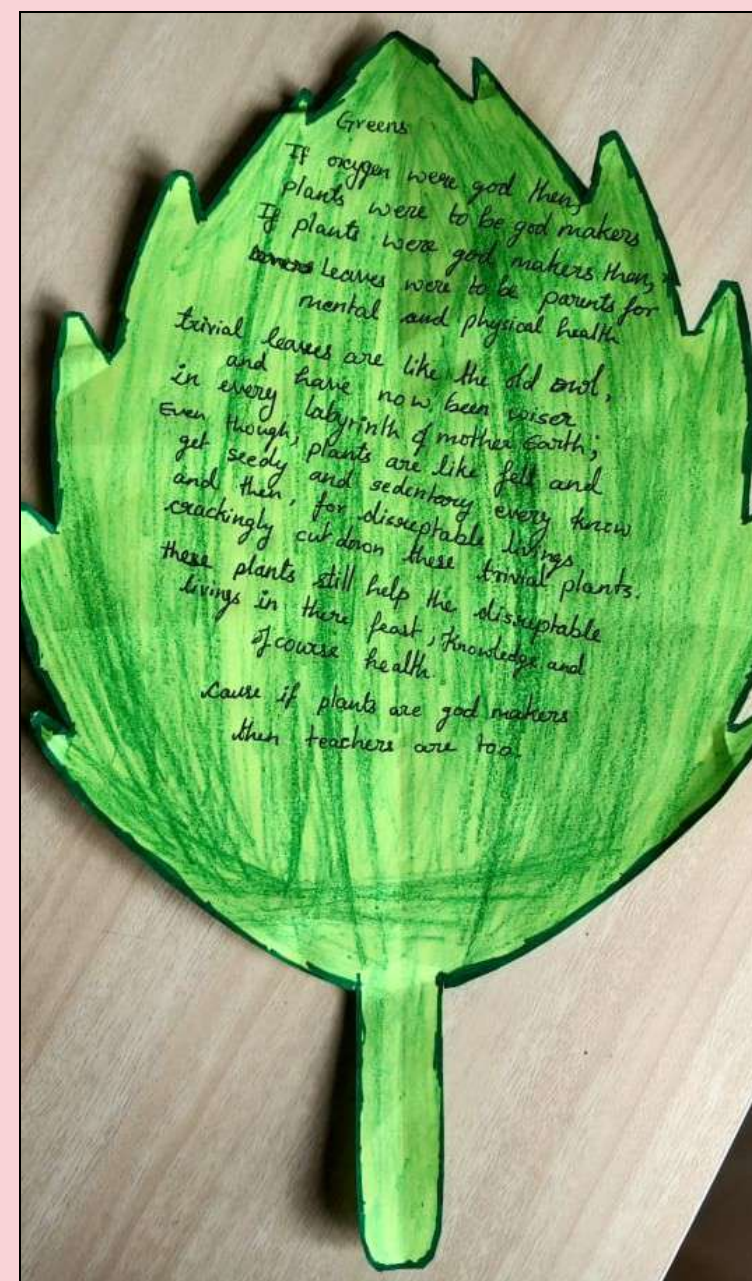

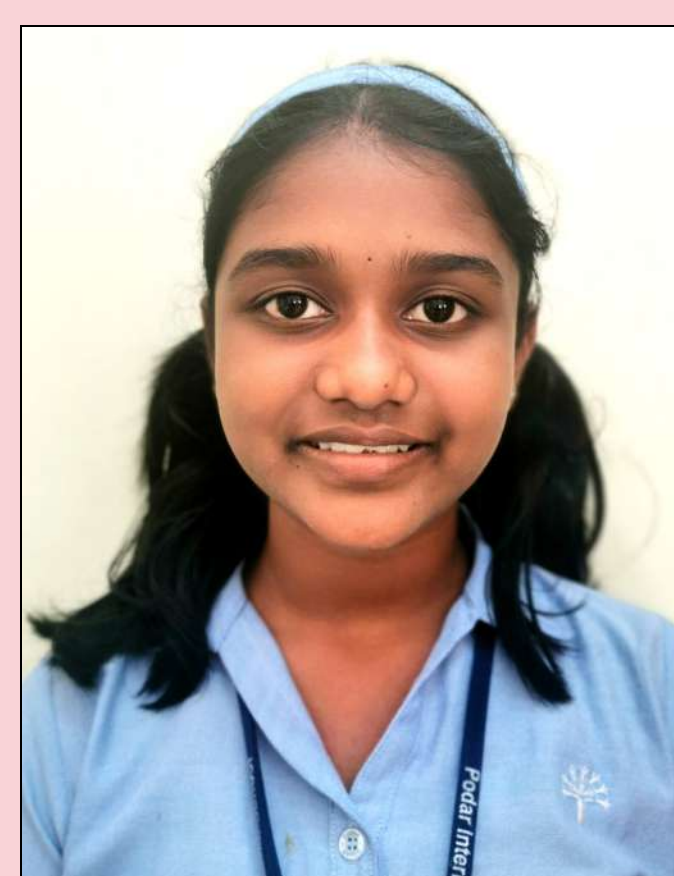

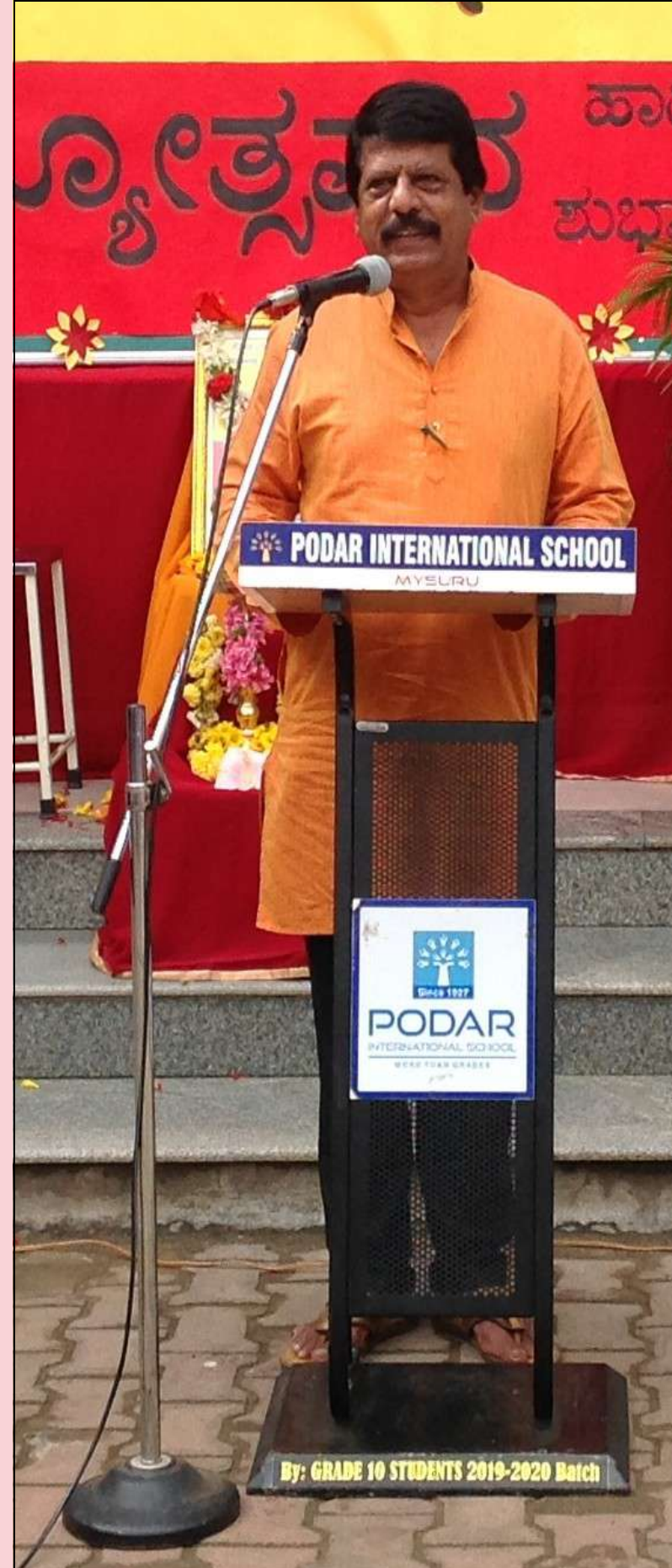
The event kick started with the sports leader and school head boy and head girl leading the troupes with 'The Sports Torch'. It was followed by a synchronous march past by all the 4 houses.
