The following points were discussed in the meeting :-

Discussion on change in school timings due to excessive heat in April 2025.

Reference :- Government circular dated 28/03/2025 regarding starting of Primary and Secondary section at 7 a.m.

Honourable Principal Sir opened the discussion on the proposed change in school timings for the Primary and Secondary classes to 7 a.m. due to heat wave for the summer months. He mentioned that the current school timings were deemed unsuitable due to extreme heat which can affect the concentration and overall well being of the children.

Proposed Changes in School Timings :-

Current Timings :- 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Proposed Timings :- 7 a.m. / 7:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

After a detailed exchange of views and considerations, the PTA members expressed their collective decision and agreed to accept the fact that change in school timings for April will be beneficial and safer.

Principal Sir also informed that the School will be giving water breaks to the students to keep them hydrated.

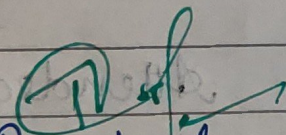
The discussion continued with Principal Sir raising a question whether to start the School at 7:00 a.m. or 7:30 a.m. To this, the parents replied 7:30 a.m. as some smaller children of Primary grades would not be finding it easier to reach by 7:00 a.m. Thereafter, Principal Sir declared that the School timing for the month of April will be 7 a.m. to 12 p.m. including water breaks and two breaks (short break as well as long break) as per time table. and informed that the School will send out an official communication to all parents informing them about the change in timings.

Academics - Suggestions :- Principal Sir asked the members to give suggestions on academics. To this, the parents requested to involve practicals in Science for classes that are in Secondary grades. Principal Sir responded that we are already working on it and that we would definitely take the suggestion into consideration. One of the parent also asked to get the activity book i.e. Practical book complete in the same idea.

Thereafter, One suggestion was raised that school can have a Parent portal wherein they can access all the notes of all the subjects so that they

can get it completed whenever needed.
Principal Sir said that the school will surely take the suggestion into consideration. He also mentioned that a variety of resources and assignments are mentioned/are available on the Loop learning portal.

With this, Principal Sir concluded that the meeting has ended with a positive note. He thanked all the PTA members for the kind co-operation and appreciation towards school and management all throughout the academic year 2024-25.
