

*The month includes activities like Std X Farewell, Jumpstart, Event, House Competition under the theme Migration Chronicles and the achievements.*



*The exemplary Principal, Mrs Anagha Gholap guided, inspired, supported for the organisation of activities and wished all for the celebrations of days.*

Theme: Migration Chronicles




*Podar International School, Ambegaon conducted the activity Jumpstart under the theme Migration Chronicles.*

*Podar International School, Ambegaon conducted the Special Assembly on The Great Migration Adventure under the theme Migration Chronicles.*


*The students highlighted how migration brings diversity and enriches communities and acceptance and understanding are essential for building strong neighborhoods.*

**Theme: Five Elements**


**Std: I & II**





Std: II


Let's Take a Trip

# Farewell


Date: 4 February 2025
