





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World Population Day

The school organised a Literary week to encourage students understanding and love for literature, improve written and spoken expression and to inculcate the habit of reading in the students.



To make the experience attractive and enjoyable for the new generation, a series of activities including Chart Making on favourite Author, speech were organised.
