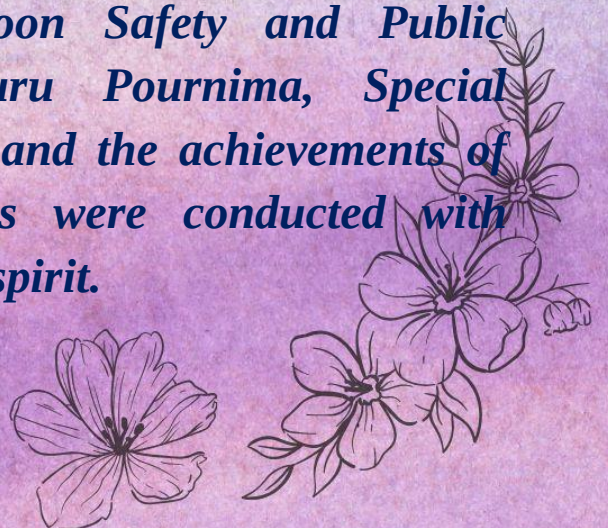
Editor's Desk

Jumpstart

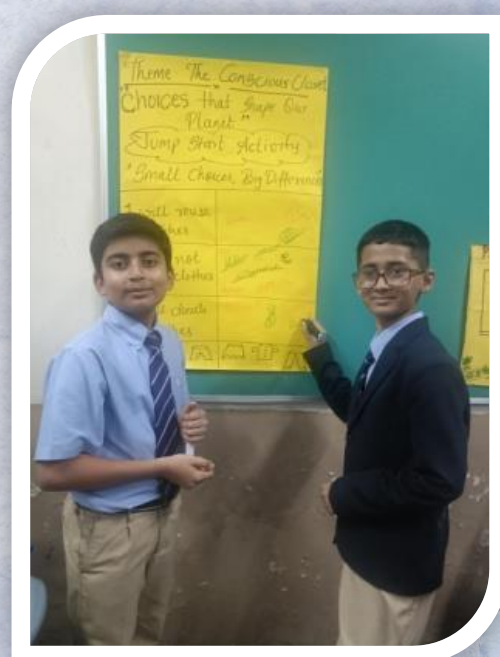
Theme - The Conscious Closet
