Let's celebrate the wonders of childhood and the promise of a great future. Happy Children's Day!



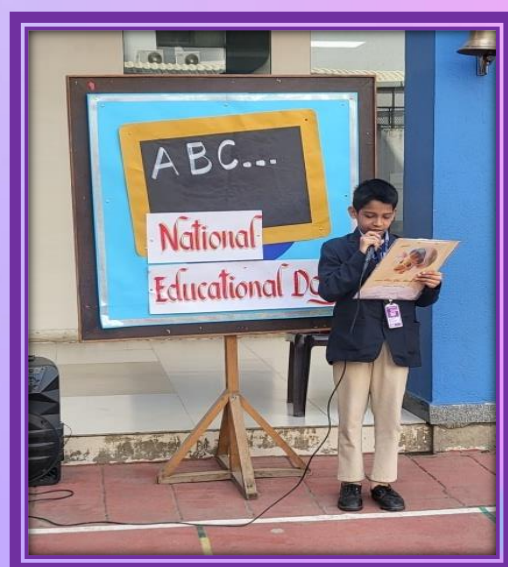
National Educational Day

Date: 15 November 2025

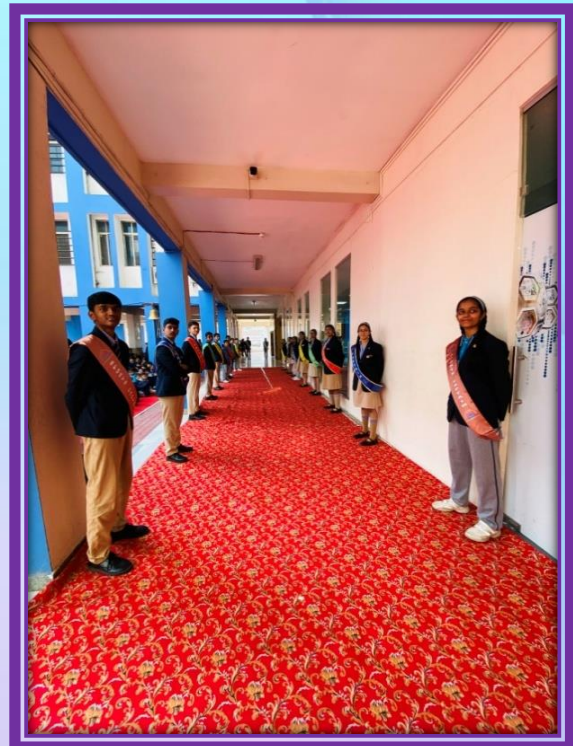
Visit Freestyle Football player
