Friends, then every time I will help.



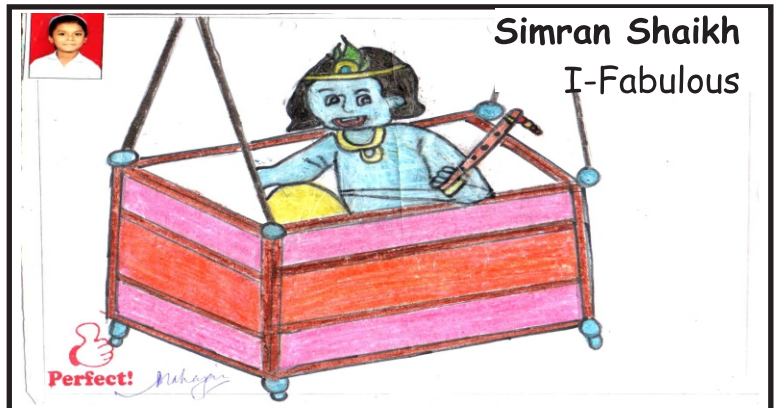

Counselling Corner:

A smart phone is a mobile with highly advanced features. A typical smart phone has a highly resolution touch screen display, wi-fi connectivity, web browsing capabilities and ability to accept sophisticated applications. The term 'smart phone' first appeared in 1997 when Ericsson described its GS88 'Penelope' concept as a smart phone.

A multitude of leisure activities like mobile gaming, streaming music, photo and video sharing on social networking sites like Facebook, Instagram, Twitter etc are associated with smart phones. A number of smart phones users in developing countries is rapidly increasing trend- especially youngsters in urban populations. We are not addicted to the information,

entertainment and personal connections (that a smart phone) delivers.

Smart phone addiction is important to address because it leads to significant disruption in social emotional and overall personality. Adolescence is critical period of transition and high level of risk taking behavior. According to UNICEF, nearly 284 million adolescents are living in India. Out of them 72% use smartphone. 17.40% of them are at risk of internet addiction.

Preoccupation of mind always being online. Attempt to hide the extent of use with family members. Frequent lies about the extent of involvement. Withdrawing from other pleasurable activities. Social isolation – prefers to be alone. Defensive attitudes and angry out burst when stop from using smartphones. Engagement in the activity as a way to escape from reality. Continuous involvement despite the negative consequences.

To manage it – Prevention – parental control, blocking certain sites, limiting time of use under supervision.

Transparent and healthy discussion, Introducing more active, real social interactions, sports. Targeting cutting down on compulsions by cognitive behavioural therapy. Need to think about – 1. The ultimate discussion of use/ overuse/ problematic use/ addiction of social networking. 2. a generation leap towards new world of communication over understanding is important.

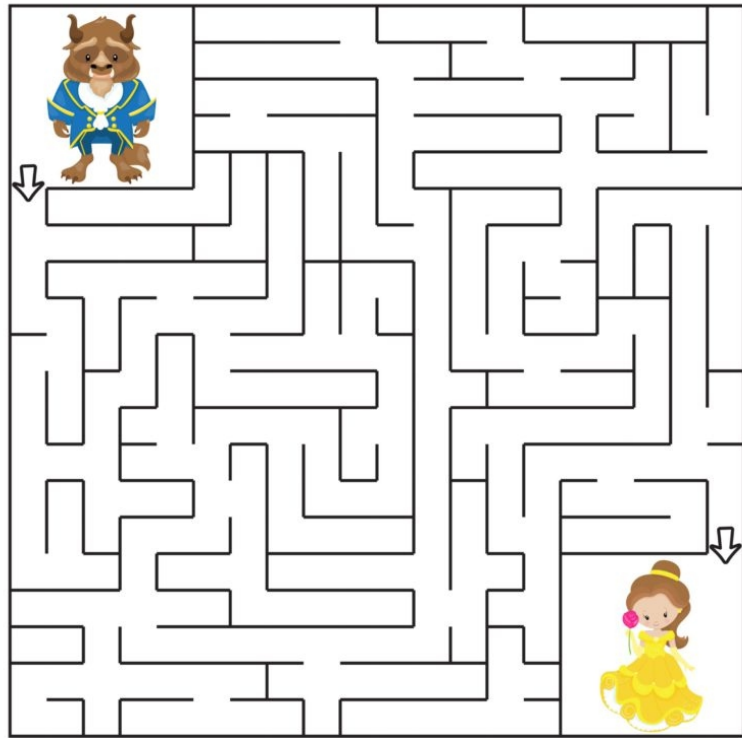
grade 7th student, Mast. Satvik Raut participated in under 15 category kids

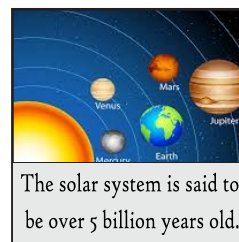

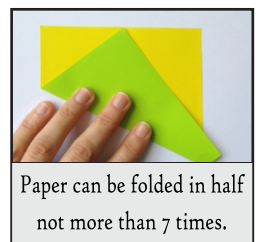
