Subject: School Uniform – An Appeal

Dear Parents,

As we begin the Academic Year 2026–27, we seek your support in ensuring that students adhere to the prescribed school uniform guidelines communicated in the Reopening Day Circular shared on 14th May 2026.

Uniform Schedule

- Sports Uniform – Every Tuesday and Thursday
- **Regular School Uniform – On all remaining working days**, irrespective of individual class timetables
- In previous academic years, students were permitted to wear the Sports Uniform on the days they had Physical Education and Yoga classes, as it provided comfort and convenience during these activities.
- However, upon reviewing the implementation of this practice, it was observed that students from the same class and grade often attended school in different uniforms on the same day based on their individual timetables. While practical, this affected the uniformity and disciplined appearance of the student body during assemblies, school events, and other common gatherings.
- With the objective of promoting consistency, discipline, and a stronger sense of school identity, the school has introduced a standardized uniform schedule for all students from Grades 1 to 10 for the Academic Year 2026–27.
- This schedule has been thoughtfully planned to ensure that students continue to have designated days for sports attire while maintaining a neat, uniform, and cohesive appearance across the school campus.
- Parents may be assured that Physical Education, Yoga, and other activity-based sessions conducted on regular uniform days have been organized keeping students' comfort, safety, and active participation in mind.
- For additional comfort girl students are requested to wear cycling shorts or beige-coloured leggings beneath their regular school uniform.

Note: Kindly note that a relaxation in the uniform schedule has been provided for students of **Grades I and II** as follows:

- **Sports Uniform:** To be worn every **Tuesday and Thursday**.
- **Regular School Uniform:** To be worn on all other working days.

However, on days when students have **PE classes**, wearing the **Sports Uniform is optional for grade 1 and 2 only**.

We request all parents to kindly support the school in implementing this policy. A consistent uniform code not only fosters discipline and school spirit but also reinforces the collective identity of our students and enhances the overall decorum of the school environment.

We look forward to your continued cooperation in helping us uphold the values and standards of our school community.
