Podar International School, Nashik (ICSE) has once again demonstrated academic excellence by achieving a 100% pass result in the ICSE Board Examinations for the academic year 2024-25. Mast. Rudra Gadge emerged as the school topper with an impressive 98.00%, followed by Sarthak Jadhav, Vihaan Khamat, and Shourya Bhagat scoring 95.17%, and Parinita Dhable and Shravani Rakshe securing 95.00%. Students also delivered outstanding subject-wise performances, with History/Civics, perfect 100/100 scores in Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Computer Applications. Out of 133 students who appeared for the examination, 19 students scored above 90%, and 22 secured marks in the 85-89% range, showcasing the school's strong academic foundation and commitment excellence.


International Yoga Day Celebrated


PRIPHU

- 1. Setup: The game is played in a designated area, typically outdoors. A pile of seven flat stones (or wooden blocks) is stacked in the center of the field.
- 2. Attacking Team: One team, the "attackers," gets to throw the ball at the stack of stones to knock them down.
- 3. Defending Team: The other team, the "defenders," tries to catch the ball after it hits the pile and before it bounces.
- 4. Rebuilding the Stack: If the defenders fail to catch the ball, the attackers try to rebuild the stack of stones while being targeted by the defenders.
- 5. Getting Players Out: If a defender hits an attacker with the ball before the stack

is rebuilt, the attacker is out.

- 6. Switching Roles: The teams switch roles after all the attackers are out or after a certain time limit.
- 7. Scoring: Points may be awarded for rebuilding the stack successfully or for getting players.



MONSOON MEMORY


