Tragic Loss

The School is deeply shocked and saddened about the tragic incident which took place on 7th February 2025.

One School student Master Neil Nilesh Kinkhkar from Grade IX F lost his life through suicide.

The School is deeply appalled at the tragic loss of life and prays to God to give courage to the family of the victim. All support is being provided to the police authorities in their investigation of this matter.

The School students will be counselled through this difficult period and the school will extend all support to the family during this difficult time.

The EPTA Members were briefed as follows on the incident that took place on 7th Feb 2025 -

1. The Master Neil Kinkhkar performed well in the recent Annual Day and was part of the orchestra on 2nd Feb 2025. He was absent for 4 days and directly reported to school on 7th Feb 2025.

- 2) As per the CCTV Footage the student entered the campus and was not found to be speaking to anyone, kept his bag in the classroom, and directly went to the canteen.
- 3) The CCTV Footage is taken by the Police Dept. which clearly shows the student by himself committed suicide.
- 4) According to Police Prima facia it is a suicide and there is no foul play. Police has registered ADR - Accidental Death Report and further investigations are going on.
- 5) From Police Dept ACP Mayur Siddam Bhujbal with his team of police Inspectors reported and investigated the incident. Forensic team was also in the campus to collect evidences if any.
- 6) The Education Officer - Ms. Azuna Yadav visited the school and we briefed her about the incident. EO expressed her heartfelt condolences for the parents.
- 7) As per the request of the parent we have arranged an Ambulance to take the deceased student to their home town Yavdmat.
- 8) Steps taken by the school includes -
 - a) Complete support and cooperation to the Police Department and the parents.
 - b) Immediate closure of the terrace areas for students.
 - c) Existing safety railings that are approximately 7 ft from the floor level. Steps being taken by the school to close all gaps above 7ft height as well to prevent the possibility of any such incident in the future.

↳ Availability and planned steps to be taken by the school counsellors to support the mental health of our students.

↳ It was discussed and decided that School Behaviour policy to be continued to follow and Zero Tolerance Policy to be followed for bullying.
