Date: 13th June 2025

Venue: School Classrooms (Separate sessions for girls and boys)

Time: Zero Period

Conducted by: In-charge Teachers

Agenda:

To introduce the Girls' and Boys' Welfare Committees and discuss key aspects of student welfare, safety, mental health, and cyber safety.

Minutes of the Meeting:

1. Welcome and Introduction

The in-charge teachers welcomed all students and explained the objective of conducting separate sessions for the Girls' and Boys' Welfare Committees. Students were encouraged to engage actively and openly in the session.

Students from **Classes 1 to 10** were present for the meeting. To ensure clarity and comfort for all age groups, the sessions were conducted using **age-appropriate language and content**, allowing students to understand and engage with the topics effectively.

2. Mode of Presentation

The meeting was conducted using a **PowerPoint presentation**, which visually outlined the key topics and helped in better understanding. The teachers used the slides to highlight the structure, objectives, and responsibilities of the Welfare Committees.

3. Importance of the Committee

*The committee serves as a platform to address issues related to student safety, hygiene, academic stress, mental and emotional well-being, gender sensitivity, and personal growth.

*It aims to create a safe and nurturing environment that promotes respect, inclusivity, and student leadership.

4. Role of the Committee

*Ensure a safe, respectful, and inclusive atmosphere in school.

*Address student welfare concerns, with a focus on gender equality.

*Organize awareness programs on personal hygiene, mental wellness, and healthy peer relationships.

*Act as a communication bridge between students and school authorities.

*Recommend infrastructure or facility improvements that support student well-being.

5. Introduction of Committee Members

***Class Representatives (CRs):** Act as spokespeople for their classmates, help relay concerns, and support event organization.

***Council Members:** Promote leadership, discipline, and peer support.

***In-charge Teachers:** Mentor committee members, provide guidance, and ensure implementation of welfare activities.

6. Student Support System

*The availability of the committee for support was reiterated.

*A **Complaints Box** has been installed at the school reception for students to share concerns anonymously if they feel uncomfortable discussing them directly.

7. Understanding Good Touch & Bad Touch

*A session was conducted to help students understand personal boundaries.

*They were encouraged to say "NO" to inappropriate touch and to report any such incident immediately to a trusted adult.

8. Introduction to Chirag App

*A student safety app initiated by the Haryana Government.

Features include:

-Real-time location tracking

- Emergency SOS alerts
- Direct access to school and police contacts
- Teachers emphasized its usefulness, especially during commutes.

9. Child Helpline – 1098

- *Introduced as a national 24x7 helpline for children in distress.
- *Run by the Childline India Foundation, it provides services such as rescue, counseling, legal aid, and shelter.
- *Students were encouraged to use the service if needed.

10. Cyber Safety Guidelines

Students were advised to:

- Never share passwords or personal details online
- Avoid chatting with unknown persons on digital platforms
- Immediately report cyberbullying or any suspicious online activity to a teacher or parent


11. Open Discussion and Experience Sharing

- *Teachers discussed some **important real-life issues and challenges** related to student safety, mental health, and cyber safety to raise awareness.
- *Students were encouraged to share their personal **experiences and concerns**.
- *Many students came forward and expressed their thoughts, which created an open and trusting environment for dialogue and mutual support.




