Guidelines for Conducting STEM, Event, Club, and Literacy & Numeracy Periods

Dear Teachers.

This is to streamline the conduct of STEM, Event/Club, and Literacy & Numeracy periods for the academic session. Kindly adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Literacy & Numeracy Periods (Grades 1–5)
 - Grades 1 & 2: Block periods will be scheduled.
 - Grades 3 to 5: One period per week.
 - You will be provided with 10 Literacy Lesson Plans and 10 Numeracy Lesson Plans (total: 20).
 - Ensure lessons are conducted as per the provided plans with age-appropriate activities.
 - Maintain proper records of topics covered in your subject register.
- 2. STEM Periods (Grades 1–8)
 - STEM periods will be conducted fortnightly as per the timetable.
 - Activities should be interactive, hands-on, and aligned with the STEM objectives.
 - Record-keeping is mandatory for each session.
- 3. Event/Club Periods (Grades 1–8)
 - The Event Period will be utilised exclusively for Club Activities.
 - You will be provided with 20 topics for clubs for:
 - o Grades 1 to 5
 - o Grades 6 to 8
 - From these, choose 2 topics per club, making a total of 22 topics for the session.
 - Preferably choose different topics for different grades to ensure variety.
 - Maintain a log of activities conducted.
- 4. Documentation & Social Media Updates
 - For every class of STEM, Literacy & Numeracy, Club, Arts, Music, Hobby, and PE, a good collection of photos and videos must be taken.
 - Share these with the school media team for scheduled posting on:
 - Facebook
 - Other social media platforms
 - School website
 - Mr. Vishal will keep track of the submissions and ensure timely posting.
