## **Change in School Timings during Half-Yearly Examination**

Dear Parents.

This is to inform you that the school will follow revised timings during the upcoming Half-Yearly Examination.

- Arrival Time: As per the regular schedule
- Departure Time for Self-Pickup Students: 11:35 am
- Departure Time for Bus Students: 11:45 am

Kindly note the following important points for smooth conduct of examinations:

- 1. Students must come in proper school uniform and carry their ID card daily.
- 2. They should bring their hall ticket, stationery items, light refreshment, and water bottle with them. Sharing of stationery will not be allowed.
- 3. Students must reach directly to the allotted classroom as per their seating plan during examination.
- 4. Parents are requested to ensure punctual pickup of students at the revised timings.
- 5. There will be preparatory leave (for Grades 3 to 10) on the days when there is no exam as per the examination timetable.
- 6. Kindly motivate your ward to prepare well in order to achieve good marks in the examination.
- 7. Grades 1 and 2 students will attend school regularly on the days other students will have exams ie. 12th, 15th, 16th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 22nd, and 23rd September 2025 following the revised school timings.
- 8. There will be only one break each day from 12th September to 23rd September for classes 1 and 2 students.
- 9. Regular school timings will resume after the examination period is over (24th September 2025 onwards).
- 10. Students are expected to bring only a transparent stationery pouch and a transparent writing board.
- 11. No electronic gadgets (e.g., smartwatches, calculators, etc.) are allowed.
- 12. Malpractice is strictly prohibited. If a student is found indulging in malpractice, strict disciplinary action will be initiated. Ten (-10) marks will be deducted, the existing answer script will be confiscated, and a new one will be issued. The student will be required to complete the paper within the remaining time, and only the new answer script will be evaluated.
- 13. All absenteeism cases will be treated as per the organisation's policy.
