About Statue of Unity

The Statue of Unity is the world's tallest statue, with a height of 182 metres (597 feet), located near Kevadia in the state of Gujarat, India. It depicts Indian statesman and independence activist Vallabhbhai Patel (1875–1950), who was the first deputy prime minister and home minister of independent India and an adherent of Mahatma Gandhi.

The project was first announced in 2010, and construction started in October 2013 by Indian company Larsen & Toubro, with a total construction cost of ₹27 billion (US\$422 million). It was designed by Indian sculptor Ram V. Sutar and was inaugurated by the Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, on 31 October 2018, the 143rd anniversary of Patel's birth.

1. SOU Viewing Deck:

Students will visit the Viewing Deck inside the Statue of Unity, offering breathtaking views from 153 meters above ground. They'll witness the Sardar Sarovar Dam, surrounding mountain ranges, and learn about the engineering marvel behind the statue. It's an inspiring blend of patriotism, science, and adventure.

2. SOU Laser Show:

An evening laser light and sound show projected on the statue narrates the life and achievements of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. The captivating visuals and synchronized music bring history to life, making learning entertaining and memorable for students.

3. Unity Glow Garden:

This LED-themed glow garden features glowing sculptures, illuminated animals, and colorful installations powered by clean energy. Students will enjoy a fun-filled walk through a magical landscape while learning about creativity and sustainable energy solutions.

4. Jungle Safari

The Jungle Safari at Statue of Unity is a 375 acre park with seven different levels ranging from an altitude or elevation of 29 meters to 180 meters. The Statue of Unity Jungle Safari route has been designed such that visitors can view animal activities, spot reptiles and watch birds in their natural habitats. Visitors will also be able to see India's endangered species including the magnificent big cats like Asiatic Lion (Royal Bengal Tiger), Leopards etc. This Jungle Safari is an adventure ride, which gives an opportunity to explore the unexplored trails and untouched natural horizons. The significant feature of this park is that visitors can see animals in an open environment and the forest will provide the effect of a Jungle Safari kind of tour. The undulating terrain of Vindhya hills makes it an ideal abode for the creatures here.
