#### NOTICE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

Dear Parents,

Greetings of the day.

Please take note of the following guidelines for the students with regard to general discipline of the school:-

- 1. Students should reach school before 07:40 am as the school assembly begins at 07:45 am.
- 2. All students are expected to come to school in their proper school uniform.
- 3. Students should wear P.E. uniform on days when they have PE, Yoga or Dance periods. On other working days they should wear their Regular blue uniform with black shoes.
- 4. Wearing of head-bands for girls is also a part of the uniform. Please ensure that the girls are tying their hair properly making plaits as per convenience and wear the blue head-band.
- 5. Boys should have proper crew-cut hair to look smart and decent students of the school. They should wear neck tie and polished shoes.
- 6. Children should make effort to speak in English on the school campus.
- 7. Use of foul, indecent and abusive language (written or verbal) will be dealt seriously and repeated similar offence will lead to expulsion of the student from the school.
- 8. Aggressive behaviour/ Physical fights /quarrels with any student(s) in the school campus/school bus will lead to suspension from school.
- 9. Students need to carry their school diaries on all working days. The School diaries are available in the school admin office for an online payment of **Rs. 150/- via the looplearning portal.** Once the payment is made please share the transaction receipt with the class teacher so that school diaries can be issued to your child.
- 10. The school is going to start the after school remedials for the weak & slow learners on Mondays, Tuesdays & Wednesdays. In case you want to enroll your child for this Specialized Personal Remediation, please meet the class teacher of your child and get your child's name enrolled for SPR. Details about the after school remediation sessions will be shared shortly.
- 11. Submission of assignments and notebooks should be a regular habit as per the insturctions of the teachers. Parents are requested to follow the written work of their children so that the notebooks, workbooks and assignment sheets are regularly checked and feedback is shared by the teacher. Counter signatures of the parents after every correction work is expected.

### NOTICE Draw of Lots for PTA Parent Representatives 2025 - 2026

Dear Parents, Greetings of the day.

In response to the Notification of Formation of PTA – Podar International School, Waluj vide Circular No. 1109 dated 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 shared with you in April, 2025, the school has received total 37 self nomination forms (online as well as offline) for PTA – representation of various Grades from 1 to 10.

Out of the 37 self nominations received **2 nominations are rejected**. The first one as both the parents (mother & father) had self nominated themselves, mother's nomination is accepted while father's self-nomination stands rejected. In the second case, one of the parents had self nominated herself for the PTA, but as she was already a PTA member in 2023 – 2024 and has not completed the mandatory 3 years period before nominating for PTA again, **her nomination was also rejected**. In both the cases the parents are informed about the rejection by the school.

As per the new guidelines mentioned in the PTA Formation, there will be only **ONE PTA representative** selected from every Class. So if there are two or more divisions only **ONE** member will be selected through Draw of Lots and she / he will be the PTA Parent Representative member for that particular class. Divisionwise representation will not be done from this point forward for PTA.

All the members of the parent body who have submitted their self nomination either online or offline are invited to visit the school on Wednesday, 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 at 09:00 am to attend the Draw of Lots for PTA Parent Representatives of various classes. This Draw of Lots will be taken in the School Library at 09:00 am. The names of the parents will be put in a box and one of the parent members will be asked to take out only one chit from the box. The name taken out from the box will be considered for the PTA – Parent Representatives of Podar Internaitonal School, Waluj for the academic session 2025 - 2026.

Please take note that out of 10 PTA Parent Representative members 6 members will be mother parents as per the guidelines of the PTA formation given in the GR of Government of Maharashtra.
